

## **What is the Curbside Market?**

The Curbside Market is a farmer's market on wheels – we go to various public housing sites, community centers, and health centers to bring fresh, local, and affordable produce to a SNAP-eligible population.

## **Where do you operate?**

We operate in throughout Rochester, Monroe County, and several counties surrounding the city. [Click here](#) to see our regular schedule.

## **What will I be doing?**

Assist Curbside Market operator in loading/unloading the truck, handle transactions, and be a health advocate by engaging with customers about eating fresh foods. Volunteers ride along in the vehicle and typically assist our operators at 2 to 3 sites. Volunteers will need to feel comfortable lifting up to 50 lbs, engaging a diverse group of community members, and doing mental math during transactions.

## **When are volunteer shifts available?**

Curbside operates Monday – Friday from 10:00AM – 6:00PM. Volunteer shifts are available in the morning and the afternoon.

## **How do I sign up?**

To sign up, click the green registration button on [our volunteer website](#). You will be able to select the Curbside shifts that you are available and submit a volunteer request. We will follow up within 48 hours to arrange a brief phone interview and on site orientation.

Please note: Due to the processing time necessary between signing up for a shift and final approval, shifts that appear open on the calendar when you register may be filled by a previous applicant. We will work with you to the best of our ability to accommodate your schedule and desired volunteer shifts.

## **What is the age requirement?**

You must be 18 years or older to volunteer on the Curbside Market.
