Foodlink buys food by the trailer, which means we are able to get food for pennies per pound. This means that for the \$1 you spend on a donated can of soup, we are able to purchase 3.6 pounds food, leveraging the power of a dollar to maximize the amount of help we are able to provide to those in need in our service area.

We host more than 15,000 volunteers a year and couldn't do the work we do without them. Volunteers work in our warehouse to sort food donations, pack produce and fill bags for our Backpack program that supports children in our area. We also have volunteer opportunities with our Nutrition Education and Food Access programs.



Our volunteers range from individuals and families to groups, organizations and businesses. We can host a group of 50 people per shift and have shifts available Tuesday-Saturday.
