Job Title: Kitchen Expediting and Delivery Support

Reports to: Community Meals Distribution Manager

Status: Full time, Hourly, Non-exempt

SUMMARY

The Kitchen Expediting and Delivery Support (KEDS) is a critical role in our meal distribution. The KEDS is part of the team that assures quality, temperature, accurate quantity of all food distributed from our kitchen. This role will fill in as needed in the Expediting Kitchen, food packing rooms, docks, or even delivering meals in our box truck or van.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Driving:

- Before starting trip, walks around truck to observe any visual defects and checks operating systems such as brakes, horn, windshield wipers, lights, first-aid kits, emergency flashers; completes all required inspection sheets, turning them into appropriate personnel.
- Loads cambro (insulated food carrier) units and meal components in full
- Picks up and delivers food items and cambros by following prescribed service route and safety rules.
- At end of route, checks truck interior, removing any waste items or trash.
- Completes all driver logs and paperwork associated with pick-ups and deliveries in a timely manner. Turns all of this paperwork into appropriate personnel, as well as filing daily food delivery slips and paper delivery slips
- When not scheduled to a service route or when the service route does not require a full eight hours to complete, assists as needed in any area of the kitchen as directed by the supervisor.

Kitchen Responsibilities:

- Responsible for ensuring quality control of meals by reheating and/or cooking food to the required temperature
- Inspects menu items to ensure that all meal components comply with food safety and quality standards.
- Responsible for coordination and consolidation of all outgoing food items from the kitchen, including milk, snack and breakfast
- Stages items needed for route deliveries, pull/wraps food to place in cambros for delivery
- Ensures that all meal components leave the kitchen for route delivery on time and accurately
- Responsible for maintaining a clean and organized routing cooler and dock area

General:

- Provides exemplary customer service both internally and externally
- Follows all sanitary and safety guidelines as required by government laws and Foodlink policies
- Represents Foodlink in a professional manner whenever interfacing with customers, donors, volunteers and/or constituent providers all while wearing approved uniform.
- Performs general housekeeping and sanitation duties as needed
- Works as a team player.
- Performs all other tasks as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must hold a current, valid NYS driver's license. CDL B a plus
- Excellent driving record, as verified through the state DMV
- High school diploma, GED, or equivalent combination of education and experience
- Knowledge of kitchen/food safety and sanitary standards a plus
- Must be able to work independently.
- Able to carry out oral and written instructions.
- Able to communicate clearly and concisely
- Able to apply mathematical concepts.
- Able to work in a team environment.
- Friendly, customer-oriented personality.
- Capable of standing and sitting for long periods of time.
- Able to lift bulk objects or objects weighing up to 60 pounds.
- Fluency in English required. Knowledge of Spanish helpful.
- COVID 19 Considerations: COVID-19 Vaccinations are a condition of employment at Foodlink. Accommodations may be made for individuals with an approved exemption.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

This is a full time, year-round position, paid on an hourly basis at \$16/hr. Foodlink covers 100% of individual health and dental insurance with the ability to acquire family coverage with pretax dollars. In addition to generous paid time off (PTO), we observe 14 paid holidays throughout the year. Opportunity to contribute to a 401k retirement savings plan upon hire. Eligible for generous employer match after 1 year of service.
