



Foodlink's Community Farm

The Lexington Ave. Community Farm consists of a large community garden, a commercial growing operation, and a public pocket park and play area. Though the Lexington Ave. Community Farm, Foodlink provides opportunities to building connections between the land, our programs, and our community.

Volunteer Duties: Volunteer tasks vary, but will typically include watering, planting/sowing, turning compost heaps, installing, and repairing irrigation, building gardening beds, general farm maintenance, deep cleaning, and more.

Physical Intensity: Volunteer tasks are considered HIGH in physical intensity. Projects will include frequent walking, standing, bending, twisting, and lifting tools (up to 25-70lbs).

What to Bring/Wear: Volunteers are required to wear closed-toed shoes and weather-appropriate attire. Volunteers are also encouraged to wear sunscreen or a hat and bring a water bottle.

Arrival & Parking: This project is located at our headquarters on 631 Lexington Ave. Rochester NY 14613. Please park in the gravel parking lot.
