Foodlink Distributes millions of pounds of donated food every year to individuals in need through our network of community partner agencies.

Volunteer Duties: Volunteers are needed to sort, inspect, and pack non-perishable food items before they are distributed to our community partner agencies.

Physical Intensity: Volunteers tasks are considered HIGH in physical intensity. Projects will include frequent walking, standing, bending, and lifting (up to 25-50lbs).

What to Bring/Wear: Volunteers are required to wear closed-toed shoes and project appropriate attire i.e clothes you wouldn't mind getting dirty and layers (sometimes the Distribution Center can be chilly).

Arrival and Parking: This project is located at our headquarters on 1999 Mount Read Blvd. Please Park in our front entrance parking lot and enter through our main entrance. Do NOT follow the signs leading to the volunteer parking lot.

COVID-19 Regulations: Foodlink is continuing to follow all CDC safety guidelines to ensure volunteer and staff safety during the COVID-19 Pandemic. Please adhere to our current guidelines:

- Volunteers should refrain from volunteering if they are sick or experiencing symptoms of COVID-19.
- Volunteers expose to COVID-19, must refrain from volunteering for at least 10-14 days and receive a negative COVID-19 test.
- Volunteers may opt out of wearing a facemask if they show proof of vaccination status
