



FAQs for Hosting a Foodlink Donation Drive

 - Foodlink is located at 2011 Mt. Read Boulevard, Rochester, NY 14615.
 - When you arrive at Foodlink, pull into the driveway closest to Ridgeway Avenue and look for the blue awning with the sign “Member Marketplace” over a set of double doors. Pull up to those double doors and we will unload your donations.
- **Can Foodlink pick up my donations?**
 - If your organization anticipates collecting a significant amount of donations, please reach out to donations@foodlinkny.org or call 585-413-5055 prior to the start of your drive. We may be able to deliver empty boxes, bins, and pallets to your location.
 - If you have collected at least twenty (20) medium sized moving boxes (approximately 18”x 16” x 18”) of donated products, Foodlink may be able to pick up your donations. Please reach out to schedule a pickup.
 - Note: we cannot pickup from residential homes, and our drivers cannot help lift boxes.
 - Donations less than 20 boxes must be dropped off at Foodlink with an appointment.
 - Alternatively, you may drop off donations to your local Foodlink member food pantry.
